

Christmas Break COVID Protocols

Given the current state of COVID transmission in San Francisco and the country, Convent & Stuart Hall has established the following schedule and protocols to protect our student and professional communities upon their return from Christmas Break.

We will have Agile Force on campus for testing days on Tuesday, December 22, Tuesday, December 29 and Tuesday, January 5.

Classes will resume on Monday, January 4, and the campus will be open for faculty and staff to deliver virtual learning plans as students engage in distance learning through Friday, January 8. This will provide time for our faculty and staff to screen for COVID-19 and also creates time for our families to follow the protocols listed below.

We ask each family to consider the health and safety of our community as you examine the following decision tree for the return of your student(s) to campus. We appreciate your partnership during this time.

Scenario 1



IF

Your family did not engage with people or households outside of your defined contact circles, nor were you exposed to increased risk of exposure through travel outside the Bay Area per the SFDPH Health Order.



THEN

Your student(s) may return to campus for in-person instruction starting Monday, January 11 after Christmas Break, provided their testing is up-to-date and on file.

Scenario 2



IF (and/or)

Your family traveled outside the Bay Area per the <u>SFDPH Health</u> Order.

Your family engaged with members of households outside your defined contact circles during the break.



THEN

The school requires your student(s) to remain at home (quarantined) for 10 days per the San Francisco Department of Health recommendation. During this period, your student(s) can engage in remote learning. The 10-day period begins the day after the activity that involved an increased risk of exposure. A student may return to campus if their testing protocol is up to date following the 10-day period. Additionally, students may test on campus during the 10-day period.

IF YOU ARE QUARANTINING

Your student(s) may also test on the 7th or 8th day after your engagement with the activity that may have increased the risk of exposure to COVID infection, and if that test result is negative, they may return to in-person instruction.
