### **MEDICATION FORM**

The Medication Form is required of any student needing prescription medication during the school day. ALL medications (**including vitamins, cough drops, ointments, Tums and herbal supplements**) must be kept in and dispensed from the school office. This is for the safety of all students. You may print the form from our school website or pick one up in the CES office.

### **IMMUNIZATIONS**

- All kindergarten students must have all required immunizations. By California law, there are **no exemptions**.
- Kindergarteners and NEW students (1-8) must send a copy of their immunization record to the school office.
- **All incoming 7th graders** MUST show proof of the Pertussis (Tdap) immunization before starting school due to California law. If you have not done so, please send in a copy of your child's immunization record to the school office before the start of school.
